LEADERS ARE DEVELOPED IN THE CHURCH


Over half of churches prefer to invest in potential leaders that are already established in their community. Less than 20% of churches seek leaders from outside of their church community.

ACTIVE ENGAGEMENT

The vast majority of churches (84%) report that between 10%-25% of their congregation's members are actively engaged in developing their leadership capacities.



LEARNING COMMUNITIES WITH COACHING

43% of churches report that they lack the mentorship efforts and learning communities necessary to develop great leaders.



SMALL GROUPS

46% of churches report that small groups are the most effective environments in which to cultivate leaders.

FACE-TO-FACE TRAINING

OVER HALF of churches prefer to conduct leadership trainings in person vs. webinars or downloadable resources.
